Additionally, assignments of recruits to work with experienced Officers shall be made as directed at the meeting of Commanding Officers. Requests for exceptions shall be made directly to the Chief of Patrol.

ASSIGNMENT OF RECRUITS

This is to clarify the General Message that was transmitted recently regarding the assignment of recruits to commands:

These recruits may be doubled in an RMP at the discretion of the Commanding Officer or Desk Officer to the extent that minimum staffing levels are not affected.

Do not double an RMP at the expense of laying up an adjoining RMP if laying up that RMP will violate the minimum staffing standards.
