

S, Riedel Highway Transfer

**STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT**  
**Grievance #12-96 - Silas Riedel Transfer**

**WHEREAS**, the PBA and the COUNTY are parties to a Collective Bargaining Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the PBA initiated a grievance under Section 8.0 et seq. of the Collective Bargaining Agreement; and


**WHEREAS**, the aforementioned parties are desirous of settling the instant matter involuntarily.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is agreed as follows:

1. The settlement of this grievance does not decide the issue of whether or not the Highway Patrol Bureau is a specialized unit. The issue of whether the Highway Patrol Bureau is a specialized unit will be decided by Arbitrator Harris.
2. It is agreed that when someone returns to the bargaining unit he/she will be placed in a non-special unit. Then he/she may not be permanently placed in a specialized unit but must respond to a posting like everyone else.
3. Thus, when Riedel returned to the unit he should have been required to apply to the Highway Patrol Bureau if the Highway Patrol Bureau is a specialized unit.
4. The parties agree that in settling this grievance, it is unnecessary to change the assignment of Riedel.
