

How To Obtain Medicare Part B Reimbursement From Nassau County After Retirement

When you (or your spouse) turn 65, you must apply for Medicare Parts A and B approximately 3 months before your 65th birthdays.

In order to obtain reimbursement from Nassau County for the cost of Medicare Part B, you must send a letter to the Nassau County Comptroller's Office, along with copies of you and your husband's Medicare cards.

The letter must be sent to:

The body of the letter must include the following:

1. Your names;
2. Your social security numbers -- or at least the last 4 digits of each of them;
3. The fact that you are a retiree of the NCPD;
4. A statement that you are submitting copies of your Medicare cards for the purpose of reimbursement of your Medicare Part B premiums.
