I appreciate everyone's support for my team and myself during the election process. In the past few months, I accomplished much in a short amount of time. The Coalition was reestablished for longevity with the other four unions and we are now moving forward with our case in front of an arbitrator. We started cutting some of the unnecessary spending and saved the membership \$132,000 annually. But, there is still much more to do, and I am sure that your new board will continue in the same direction.

### **LONGEVITY**

Our longevity arbitration is rescheduled to January 25th due to the upcoming changes in the County administration and the PBA board. The Coalition and I felt that this is the best option for our memberships. So, stay tuned in the new year to see how our case proceeds through the arbitration process.

I would like to wish the current board members—Pete Paterson, Dean Losquadro, Tommy O'Reilly, Kenny Cortes, and Billy Purcell—happy and healthy retirements. The time and dedication of these men for the benefit of our membership will be greatly missed.

### **Legal Report**

Being able to speak with clients on a regular basis, gives us quite the opportunity to interact with the men and women of the Police Department to find out what is occurring in their respective commands. For us, obviously our concerns are always regarding injuries on the job and how they are being handled. As we approach the conclusion of another trying year, we always find it appropriate to go over many of the things we have heard recently that need to be addressed as well as those points that need to be stressed over and over so that valuable and important benefits are not lost or put in jeopardy.

With the start of holiday party season, one of the biggest things that struck us from our conversations at the parties were the number of young members that had

gotten injured yet really had done very little towards protecting themselves completely. For starters, just because you are injured in the line of duty and report that injury to your supervisor does not mean that everything has been done to protect you in the future. This is especially true for injuries which the member does not think will cause him/her to miss much time from work or will need very much medical care in the future. Here is the reality: if a full injury packet is not completed and all the Workers' Compensation forms are not completed thereafter, a member is always at risk of having that injury become a headache (no pun intended) years later. This is exactly the reason why we almost always advise against doing non-recordables. Recently, a member slipped off a curb at a domestic and felt a twinge in his knee. He called my cell phone to ask what needed to be done because his supervisor had suggested just doing a non-recordable. We advised against it especially considering that the member had a prior knee injury, and the act of slipping off a curb is a new bonafide line of duty injury. We also suggested that he get his own treating orthopedist to examine him in the following few days because the emergency room was likely to simply do an x-ray and release him. Over the next few days, the "twinge" became more painful and after having an MRI performed, this member was diagnosed with a tear in the knee. By filing a complete packet early on, this member had no difficulty getting the treatment and diagnostics authorized quickly and efficiently. Plus, there is absolutely no way of knowing if all of this would have been handled as quickly and smoothly if weeks later the member asked to convert his non-recordable into a full packet or if the powers that be would have started to give the member a hard time. It is simply easier to do a complete packet right away.

The other thing to keep in mind when injured in the line of duty is that beyond reporting the injury to your supervisors and making sure they know about the event, you should also reach out to your PBA delegate and/ or trustee to let them know what happened. Countless times we have been asked to get involved in members' problematic situations only to find out, when we reach out to the trustee or delegate, they know nothing about the injury or the case. This can be especially problematic in cases regarding line of duty injuries or recurrences where the Police Surgeons or MAO might be disagreeing with the member or the member's doctor. Obviously, our feeling is that the sooner we can address any issues, then the more likely we are to get a favorable result for the member. Therefore, whenever a member gets injured, there is no reason for that member not to inform their delegate, or their trustee, and then get in touch with our office so we can make sure that the Workers' Compensation paperwork is properly completed.

Which brings us to the most important point of all... the evolution of any disability claim from Workers'

Compensation to a 3/4 Accidental Disability Retirement case, which begins and ends with the proper development of the claim and an award of benefits. Every claim begins with an on-the-job event - and from that event the entire claim can be either successful or problematic. Therefore, whenever a member is involved in a workrelated injury, they have no reason not to contact their delegate or trustee and then our office for help. You have SEVEN DAYS to write your accident statement. Therefore, take the time and care to do it accurately and completely because what is written initially cannot be fixed most of the time. We prefer to get involved right from the start so any hurdles can be kept as molehills instead of watching them grow into mountains. And as always, we remind you that every consultation is free, so sitting down with us or contacting us over the phone as soon as you can is in each member's best interest.

One of the other major reasons to keep as many people in the loop as possible also relates to the interplay between these cases. Just because someone has a workers' compensation claim that is fully established and seems to be running smoothly, it does not mean that the member might not have a problem with MAO or the police surgeons if that member is put back to restricted duty or something of that nature. Further, just because a member is out on a line of duty claim and then has a disability pension pending with the Retirement System does not preclude the Department from then having that member evaluated to come back to work in any capacity if the police surgeon deems the officer to be capable of performing either full or restricted duty. In this instance, the members would certainly avail themselves of utilizing the Medical Review process. However, if your Sgt at Arms, or your trustee, or your delegate is unaware of your Medical Review claim, the claim then becomes incredibly difficult to help protect members in the best way possible. So, to that end, the more that we are involved early in the process, the better we can protect a member if anything like this were to occur in the future. We have also found that there are members completely unfamiliar with the Medical Review process, so we suggest that all members take the time to talk to anyone of their PBA representatives to make sure they know how to use the process when the time comes.

Over the course of the past year, as well as years past, many members of the Police Department have extended very many courtesies to us and members of our firm. We thank each and every PBA member for their considerations.

removed him from the apartment.

Officers then went back inside the apartment and removed all the Victims from inside the home in order to ensure their safety from the fire. Uniondale Fire Department then responded and extinguished the fire. Defendants were charged with Arson 2nd, Menacing 2nd and CPW 4th. Great work boys, sounds like a real mess of a situation.

I would like to give a Special Buffy Spotlight to PO Hauk, PO Clarke, not that one, PO Mateo, and PO DiDonato. On November 4th, Members of the First Precinct Special Patrols along with Hauk, Clarke, Mateo, and DiDonato conducted Operation Baldy at Centennial Park in Roosevelt. Further investigation of the traffic stop yielded a loaded Glock 19 handgun with three additional magazines and a loaded Mossberg 12 gage shotgun. The individual was placed into custody and transported to the 8th precinct for arrest processing. If not for the seasoned experience of officers McCartney and Loesch, this fine outstanding citizen could still be out on the streets. Both

officers are grinding it out everyday, to make sure the streets of Nassau are safe. COPE doesn't only hand out safety pamphlets and Frisbees, they make great arrests like this one. Nice grab boys....keep up the great work.



### Dear PBA Member,

Periodically, your PBA reminds its membership of appropriate steps that should be taken if you are called to Internal Affairs or become part of ANY department investigation. Recent events underscore the importance of involving the PBA and your legal counsel, me, as soon as possible.

Should you be called to Internal Affairs, be it as a witness or subject, you must notify your local PBA representative IMMEDIATELY. If you are deemed a subject, you have the right to have both a union representative and legal counsel with you during the interview. If the investigation is criminal in nature, call me first!

REMEMBER: You must be afforded a reasonable amount of time to contact a PBA representative and attorney. You have the right to confer with us both before and after questioning.

### YOUR PBA REPRESENTATIVES AND ATTORNEY ARE HERE TO PROTECT YOU!

In any situation, be it at Internal Affairs or otherwise, where you are asked to write a letter and there is even a remote possibility of discipline, be sure to begin the letter with the following statement:

"I am making this statement for administrative purposes only. I have not done so voluntarily, but in compliance with an order of a Superior Officer. This statement in no way constitutes any waiver of my rights, and this statement, or any part thereof, may not be used against me in any subsequent criminal proceeding."

Finally, upon notifying your PBA representative that you have been called to Internal Affairs as the subject of an investigation, we will arrange to meet prior to your interview at my office to review the facts and circumstances.
