

Legal Report

When it comes to writing our Legal Report each month, the constant thing that rings in our heads is what would be the most important information to get out to the membership that directly affects his or her job and future benefits. And undoubtedly, the thing that pops up most often is the issue of "accident" vs. "incident" when it comes to getting and obtaining 3/4 Accidental Disability benefits. However, there are a number of other types of injuries that are equally important to discuss in terms of protecting oneself beyond just that 3/4 accident.

For starters, we have to start with the current status of "accidents" with the Retirement System. As you have seen for years reading our articles, the courts have consistently been whittling down the definition of what constitutes an accident into something that barely resembles what it would have covered 25 years ago. Unfortunately, that is the reality of the situation and not one that the courts appear willing to change. However, our office has seen this coming based on the vast experience we have in this area, so the Nassau County Police Department members have been moving in this direction well in advance of what the courts have been doing. It goes without saying that our job is always to keep you informed and keep you protected. We think we have done a pretty good job of that over the years, and the results speak for themselves.

That is why we had absolutely no surprise when earlier this year the Third Department Appellate Division adopted our argument on an accident case that involved a New York State Court Officer. We have been able to read the trends on this accident issues for years, and we saw that the court and the Retirement System were seeming to adopt the position that although the case law has always defined an accident that is something that is "unexpected", what they really were learning towards was that the cause of the injury had to be something outside the control of the member and something that they could not "anticipate". Thus, what we have now is what we would call the "Anticipation Doctrine" as it relates to accidents on the job.

Essentially what the Retirement System now has to apply is whether or not the risk that caused the injury could have been anticipated by the injured person. If the answer is that the risk could have or should have been seen or anticipated then it will not be an accident as defined under the law. On the other hand, if the risk could not have been reasonably anticipated by the person then they were injured as a result of an accident and not an incident. This completely falls in line with the mantra that we have been talking about for at least the last decade. If you recall our prior articles and seminars where we discussed being in control of the action that

causes the injury then that completely matches up to the person being able to anticipate that outcome or the risk. Further, the accident statements that we have helped write over that same period of time have always taken this logic into account as well. Thus, Nassau County PBA members have been incredibly well protected from this "change" in the law, and it was one that we anticipated ourselves.

In addition to this new language coming about from accident cases, we also have to be aware of the other types of injuries that can equally be covered by line of duty injuries and Workers Compensation. These include heart impairments caused by the over exertional nature of the job such as heart attacks or strokes. These need to be particularly well documented if the injuries happen due to work activities. If someone was wrestling with a large perp and then went home and had a heart attack that night, that should be covered under both line of duty doctrine and Workers Compensation if a medical physician believes that the over exertion to the heart was caused by the work activities. In addition, there might be cases such as hearing loss that might be caused either by traumatic exposure to an explosion or something along those lines or the occupational nature of hearing loss such as someone assigned to the gun range for a good portion of their career. These cases can also be compensable under Workers Compensation and need to be protected appropriately.

As you can see, there are issues that pop up repeatedly during the work day and throughout a career than can be a pitfall that should be covered. Of course, if there are not treated correctly then all of the benefits that those injuries might confer could be lost entirely. We are a resource that we hope that every member feels comfortable using to protect themselves or their families when these type of situations occur. Prior to attending IAU as a subject or witness, be sure to throughly watch any body camera footage, IAU will know what's on your body camera better than you will. You have the right to request Medical Review at the surgeon's office if there is a dispute about your line of duty status, you are ordered to return to work while on sick leave, or ordered back to full duty from light duty status.

WELCOME ABOARD

Congratulations to our newly minted Marine Bureau members. PO's Castka, D'Antone, Karimi, Killeen, MacGregor, Saladino and Walter have seen their Temporary Assignment come and go and have now been permanently assigned to the unit. You all have done a great job this season and are certainly deserving of the transfer. However, the process doesn't stop here. I urge you guys to continue to learn and hone your skills as Marine Patrol officers. You've only seen a small fraction of what you will encounter out on the high seas. Employing a proactive approach is a key part of reaching and maintaining proficiency.

ACCIDENT WITH INJURIES

On Saturday, September 10 at approximately 1300 hours, PO's Rooney and Ficalora were working aboard Marine 1 and responded to a Distress Response assignment in Oyster Bay Harbor.

Upon arrival, the crew determined that the subject vessel, a 2007 Bayliner, was cruising at the aforementioned location and had struck a large wake. The impact resulted in a back injury to the operator and a leg injury to the passenger. Marine 1 crew, working in conjunction with Atlantic Steamer and Bayville Fire Departments, quickly expedited hospital transports for the victims to receive medical treatment. The crew then assisted in securing

the subject vessel for tow and hauling purposes. All in a days work. Nice job, boys.

DOG DAYS

On Monday, September 12 at approximately 1115 hours, PO's Stassi and Litvinski were working aboard Marine 11 and responded to a Radio Assignment in the vicinity of Plum Point, Oyster Bay. Having heard a VHF Channel 16 radio broadcast, the crew were aware that reports indicated that a dog was in the water near buoy #5.



Upon arrival, several boats were attempting to rescue the canine but were unable to do so. PO's Stassi and Litvinski were able to successfully rescue the dog and brought her aboard the patrol vessel for transport back to Roosevelt Park Marina where she was then taken to a local Veterinary Hospital for evaluation and treatment. Fortunately, the dog was tired but not harmed, had a microchip and was reunited with her owners. Nice job, boys.

FATAL ACCIDENT

On Saturday , September 10, PO's McGovern, Siesto and Cernilli were working a night tour aboard Marine 4 in Freeport. At approximately 0430 hours, the crew received a Radio Assignment for an overdue/missing boater. According to reports, the operator had departed his waterfront residence in Seaford at 1730 hours and had not returned home. Marine 2 crew made contact with the complainant, the operator's wife, and then commenced a search of the area waterways. At around 0630 hours, the NYS Parks Police received a call for a deceased human body in the surf at Jones Beach West End 2. The crew then responded to the vicinity to assist and determine if it was related to the missing person.

Upon arrival, a body was observed which matched the description of the missing. Commanding Officer Lieutenant Fischer, who had responded via RMP, entered the water and recovered the body himself with assistance from NYS Police personnel. It was determined that the body was indeed that of the overdue boater. Shortly thereafter, the subject vessel was located a mile east in the surf. The vessel had been involved in an

accident which resulted in the death of the operator and is currently under investigation.

The day tour crew, PO's Dennington, MacGregor and Walter, signed on duty and responded to secure the crime scene, gather evidence and assist in the subsequent removal and transport of the subject vessel for accident reconstruction by the Marine Accident Investigator and Homicide Squad.

This accident was a highly complicated situation. It had many moving parts and all Marine Bureau members involved, including SP-1 ops PO's Beard and Ruzika, should be commended for their professionalism in handling this difficult set of circumstances. Hats off to all of you, especially to our CO for leading by example.

HELPING HAND

On Sunday, October 9, PO's Larsen and Stassi were working a day tour aboard Marine 11 in Oyster Bay. At approximately 1830 hours, while monitoring the police radio, they heard a Second Precinct officer calling for assistance forthwith. The operator of RMP 204 was in the process of investigating a Domestic Disturbance at a nearby Yacht Club when the subject became noncompliant and a violent struggle ensued. Without a second thought, PO's Larsen and Stassi quickly responded to the location and helped take the violent subject into custody. Way to go boys! That's how it is done.

JONES INLET UPDATE

As of mid-October, the Jones Inlet dredging process commenced with crews working daily to make our Inlet a safe, navigable waterway once again. Any boaters in question of where safe passage takes place on any given day should contact the USCG or the dredge operator on VHF Channel 16.





DIVE TEAM OPS

Back on Thursday, June 16, a vehicle belonging to an active missing person under investigation was recovered on the Southern State Parkway near Exit 21 adjacent to Coes Neck Lake. The vehicle was found to have possibly been involved in an auto accident and a search of the area commenced.

The NCPD Marine Bureau Dive Team was called in to conduct a search using marine dive assets while utilizing Side Scan Sonar. However, an extensive search yielded negative results.

Subsequent review of Side Scan Sonar data led to an additional search on Saturday, June 18 and a successful recovery of the body of the missing in 22' of water.

The Police Divers involved were: PO's Locher, Kogan, Zylinski, Carlson, Beard and Stassi. PO Kogan was instrumental in the data analysis leading to the successful search. In addition to the NCPD Marine Bureau Dive Team, Emergency Services Unit, Aviation Unit and Missing Person Squad were all involved. As always, great work boys!



SIDE SCAN SONAR TRAINING

As a result of the above listed Dive Team ops, on Tuesday, October 4, the NCPD Marine Bureau hosted a 2-day inter-agency training initiative that was attended by Dive Team and Training Staff members. In addition, personnel from 9 other agencies, including: NYPD Harbor Unit, SCPD Marine Bureau, Town of Hempstead Bay Constables, Town of Oyster Bay Bay Constables, Glen Cove Marine Patrol among others, were present for this valuable training.

The manufacturer of the Side Scan Sonar equipment, Marine Sonic Technology, provided an instructor to teach the proper use and implementation of sonar technology in the marine law enforcement environment.

Marine Sonic Technology is a premier domestic and international supplier of Side Scan and Collision Avoidance Sonars and Depth Sounders/Altimeters. They are one of the top companies in the industry and it was such a great experience to learn directly from the manufacturer of this essential equipment.

Day 1 consisted of detailed classroom instruction with Day 2 being a practical, hands on demonstration using the equipment out on the patrol vessels. Certainly a great training opportunity with special thanks going out to PO Kogan for orchestrating the sessions and Lt. Fischer for logistical support in securing a state-of-theart facility at the Morrelly Homeland Security Center.

ON THE JOB

I hope everyone had a Happy Thanksgiving and has a Merry Christmas, Happy Hanukkah, and enjoy the time with your families. ESU has been building relationships with the volunteer fire service and began working closely with the FD Technical Response Teams. On Saturday November 19th, ESU joined the FD tech rescue teams for a joint training in Freeport. ESU, Electronics came down with drones, Massapequa FD, Freeport FD, Bethpage FD, Rockville Centre FD, Port Washington FD, and Nassau County OEM were all in attendance. The drill consisted of victims in a basement and the only way to access them was through the concrete floor above. We were split into two teams, one in which they used concrete cutting chainsaws, and the other was all pneumatic chipping tools. Both sets of tools showed their strengths and weaknesses, and once the floors were breached ESU took place for the "rescue." PO's Paratore and Russo were lowered via the tripod in one scenario and used a portable ladder in the other. It was a great drill not only to get hands on the tools but to show face and work together to get the job done. Hope there will be more opportunities for joint training in the future.

Periodically, your PBA reminds its membership of appropriate steps that should be taken if you are called to Internal Affairs or become part of ANY department investigation. Recent events underscore the importance of involving the PBA and your legal counsel, me, as soon as possible.

Should you be called to Internal Affairs, be it as a witness or subject, you must notify your local PBA representative IMMEDIATELY. If you are deemed a subject, you have the right to have both a union representative and legal counsel with you during the interview. If the investigation is criminal in nature, call me first!

REMEMBER: You must be afforded a reasonable amount of time to contact a PBA representative and attorney. You have the right to confer with us both before and after questioning.

YOUR PBA REPRESENTATIVES AND ATTORNEY ARE HERE TO PROTECT YOU!

In any situation, be it at Internal Affairs or otherwise, where you are asked to write a letter and there is even a remote possibility of discipline, be sure to begin the letter with the following statement:

"I am making this statement for administrative purposes only. I have not done so voluntarily, but in compliance with an order of a Superior Officer. This statement in no way constitutes any waiver of my rights, and this statement, or any part thereof, may not be used against me in any subsequent criminal proceeding."

Finally, upon notifying your PBA representative that you have been called to Internal Affairs as the subject of an investigation, we will arrange to meet prior to your interview at my office to review the facts and circumstances.

PBA POLICE ACTIVITY "QUOTA" INTAKE SHEET

Labor Law 215-a prohibits the County from taking adverse employment action against an employee for failing to meet a quota. A quota is defined as a requirement that a specific number of tickets or summonses, arrests, or stops be made/issued within a specified period of time.
