We are learning the tragic and devastating details surrounding the deaths of two NYPD Officers, who were victims of an ambush-style execution. We have learned of 22 year-old, Police Officer Jason Rivera, who was executed while on a domestic violence call. We also learned, just today, that Police Officer Wilbert Mora had succumbed to his injuries.

I planned on writing this newsletter on the topic of longevity, contract, health insurance, body cameras, and the day-to-day working conditions. After learning of this news, I realized that I could not do that - and instead, I wanted to share my emotions with you.

As I am surrounded by my family right now, I feel numb, sad, and angry - emotions that I know each of you share. The reason that we feel this way is because of the forever bond that all Police Officers share. We know that this could have happened to any one of us. Our families, friends, and communities are all saddened, sickened to their stomachs about this incident and the lives lost. Truth is, while others may express support, no one can truly understand the feelings that incidents like these cause unless they have worn our uniform - and they do not understand how deeply hurt we are.

This tragedy made me rethink what I would write about, and, the most important job that I have as your PBA President is to keep you safe. Safety takes precedence over contracts, insurance, and pensions.

I am disgusted and in disbelief with the current conditions facing law enforcement in this State and across the country. It sickens me to think that some people see the police as the enemy and the criminal deserves a free pass. This is why, now more than ever, we need to be united and back each other up.

We promise to you that we will always have your back, and always fight for your safety and future. We will get through this together, and good will defeat evil.

Please stay alert, back each other up, and stand proud.

And, always, keep Police Officer Jason Rivera, Police Officer Wilbert Mora, their families, and the entire NYPD in your thoughts and prayers.

BUFFY'S SPOTLIGHT

On December 19th, Special Patrols Officers Gironda and Stephani while conducting Crime Deterrent Patrol at the Coliseum Motor Inn conducted a VTL stop and observed the passenger, who is a known, violent Gang Member and was found to be in possession of narcotics. During subsequent investigation suspect was also found to be in possession of a loaded .40 caliber handgun. Officers with prior knowledge that the suspect was also a person of interest in numerous bank robberies in Nassau notified Robbery Squad who responded to the First Precinct.

Suspect was charged with Criminal Possession of Controlled Substance, Criminal Possession of a Weapon 3rd 2 counts, Criminal Possession of Weapon 2nd, and 2 counts of Robbery 1st for the bank robberies. Great work boys!!! Hardware, and Bank Robberies Outstanding!!!!!

On 12/30/2021 at about 11:00 P.M. three suspects entered the BP Gas Station located at 1878 Hempstead Turnpike. East Meadow. One suspect approached the victim who was the lone employee behind the counter and pointed a handgun at him as he and the other suspects demanded cash and lottery tickets from him. The victim in fear for his safety started to hand about \$976 and lottery scratch off tickets under the clear plastic Covid partition, the suspects took the proceeds and then shoved into a gray bag. When the suspects fled the gas station a witness followed them as they ran to suspects blue 2012 Dodge Caravan, which was parked on Stone Ave. A description of the vehicle was transmitted over the police radio to responding officers. Officer Stephani observed the vehicle on Prospect Ave and East Meadow Ave and attempted a VTL stop when they fled. The suspects drove onto the Southern State Parkway at Newbridge Rd and ran over a traffic sign which disable the vehicle. The three suspects all ran from the officers onto the parkway. PO Gironda observed one of the suspects running in the westbound lanes of the Southern State Parkway and used his RMP to block the middle lane of the Parkway as numerous vehicles were driving around the RMP putting the suspect and PO Gironda in grave danger. The suspect refused orders to stop by officers and was taken to the ground by PO Stephani, Gironda, Winwood, and Makastchian as they attempted to handcuff him as he violently refused officers verbal commands, refusing to provide his hands and pulling them away from officers. All of this, while vehicle traffic was still moving on the Southern State Parkway, in the dark. That right there is some Buffy stuff. One suspect ran across the parkway to the southside where he was arrested by PO Riccio and PO Havens. The third suspect ran across the parkway to the southside where he hid in the brush until PO Munnelly and his K9 located him and with ESU PO Fliedner placed him into custody. Inside the suspect's vehicle was a large amount of lottery scratch off tickets, money and a loaded handgun. Search of the suspects also recovered a large clear plastic bag with 17 smaller clear plastic bags with a white powdery substance believed to be cocaine. The total weight was approximately 6.9 grams. The suspects were charged with Robbery 1st, Robbery 2nd, Criminal Possession of a Firearm, Criminal Possession of a controlled substance 3rd, and 4th as well as Resisting Arrest. This crew was involved in numerous other armed gas station Robberies around the County. This is the Buffiest of Spotlights. This was a great job by all involved. This has PBA TOP COP of the Month written all over it!! Hint Hint PBA Board lol. Seriously outstanding work!!

PO Mike Spadacinni arrived here via the NYPD in 2004. Nine years before that, in June of 1995, Mike began his career/life of public service working in the 113th for the NYPD. After making a name for himself, his upward trajectory led him to be temporarily assigned to Queens narcotics as an undercover narcotics officer. Mike proved his worth to that unit, taking dangerous drugs and bad dudes off the mean streets. After that stint, Mike returned to the 113th where he would serve

until Nassau requested his helping hand in the summer of 2004. The 8th Precinct came calling after the academy, where Mike arrived here with the likes of PO's now Lt's Mike Destefano and Adam Fisher, Mike Bjornstad, Marissa Caroselli and Andy Deverna. 

Dear PBA Member,

Periodically, your PBA reminds its membership of appropriate steps that should be taken if you are called to Internal Affairs or become part of ANY department investigation. Recent events underscore the importance of involving the PBA and your legal counsel, me, as soon as possible.

Should you be called to Internal Affairs, be it as a witness or subject, you must notify your local PBA representative IMMEDIATELY. If you are deemed a subject, you have the right to have both a union representative and legal counsel with you during the interview. If the investigation is criminal in nature, call me first!

REMEMBER: You must be afforded a reasonable amount of time to contact a PBA representative and attorney. You have the right to confer with us both before and after questioning.

YOUR PBA REPRESENTATIVES AND ATTORNEY ARE HERE TO PROTECT YOU!

In any situation, be it at Internal Affairs or otherwise, where you are asked to write a letter and there is even a remote possibility of discipline, be sure to begin the letter with the following statement:

"I am making this statement for administrative purposes only. I have not done so voluntarily, but in compliance with an order of a Superior Officer. This statement in no way constitutes any waiver of my rights, and this statement, or any part thereof, may not be used against me in any subsequent criminal proceeding."

Finally, upon notifying your PBA representative that you have been called to Internal Affairs as the subject of an investigation, we will arrange to meet prior to your interview at my office to review the facts and circumstances.
