# **Third Precinct**

# SERVICE ORIENTED POLICE DEPARTMENT?

Approximately 16 Years ago, after serving overseas with the Army, I entered into the first class of the "New" Massapequa Elementary, Nassau County Police Academy, as a young recruit.

Lecture after lecture, each and every academy staff member, including bosses, instilled in us that we are a service-oriented police department offering the citizens of Nassau County a form of Policing that focused on interacting and gaining the trust of our residents. This was most evident when the Chief of the Department, at that time, walked into our classroom and addressed our class. To this day, his speech has had the greatest impact on my career. He talked about what was expected as a Nassau County Patrol Officer. He emphasized the importance of public outreach and going the extra mile for the residents. He addressed how important it is to learn your post and more importantly to interact with the community because they are the ones we serve. He then told a story that went like this:

"A police officer received a fire alarm on his post. When the Officer arrived on scene, it was an elderly lady, that was concerned there was a fire in her house. The Officer quickly realized the fire alarm was beeping because the battery was low. The officer asked if she had a battery so the officer could replace the old one. The little old lady did not. The officer then, on his own, went to the local store and purchased a battery for the lady. The officer responded back to scene and replaced the battery for her. The elderly female invited the officer to sit down with her and have a cup of coffee. The officer did and spent time with her giving her support and companionship."

That is what defines a great Police Officer. A person that goes above and beyond the calling. When I began my career in the Third Precinct, it motivated me to build a trust between myself and the community. At the start of every tour. I would go to the local coffee shop and talk to the business owner and their customers. I created a bond and trust with a multitude of people that came from different ethnic races, backgrounds and income levels. There was "Bobby the Baker", "Frankie Flowers", "Mikey the Insurance guy", "Ronnie the Barista", and many others that I became acquainted with on a daily basis. I got to know where they lived, their children, their spouses, while gaining their trust and respect. I believe that because of my actions, when one of them got arrested, they did not fight with the officers. They respected the process and promised to make a positive change in their life, in which they did. Service oriented! That is what was instilled in us as recruits, and that is the

what Nassau's finest has always done for generations.

I believed that this type of policing is what led this County to be named the "Safest County in the United States." The evidence showed "WE" were doing something "RIGHT"!!

Now, unfortunately, the Department has determined that the measure of a good cop should no longer be based on service-oriented Policing, but rather analytics, stats, and "activity". The department no longer judges a Patrol Officer on the service he delivers to Nassau County. The Officer replacing the fire alarm has no place because he doesn't check the right boxes. The higher the numbers in those boxes are, the better you are as a Police Officer.

The next thing that the department has become reliant on is, watching and grading us based on dots on a map. What exactly does that mean? When an officer drives around in their RMP, it leaves dots on a computer map. When a report is run by a supervisor, they can see what that officer was doing during their tour and where they were. These reports are then scrutinized to the highest degree and no matter what answer that is given in response to the officer's whereabouts, nothing would ever be good enough. They expect robots to drive around constantly, without stopping, except to write a ticket. If that dot moves all the time, the officer did a great job. Well, I am not sure how that can be viewed as a great job! What made this department great was the personalities of our officers that communicate with the public. How could anyone build trust or gain vital intelligence with anybody, if we are not allowed to stop?

Unfortunately, if it were today, the story of that officer who changed the battery, and spent an hour with the elderly lady would end with him writing a letter explaining why his dots weren't moving. Imagine that... I can't, but I'm sorry to say, this is what is happening every day. The longer it goes on, the longer we lose touch with the community that we serve and patrol in. Nassau County Police Department was ahead of the curve in Policing. It saddens me to say, that this no longer appears to hold true, as we have regressed to the over bearing practices that many communities and departments strive to change.

# 8th Precinct

### **TOP COPS**

The Top Committee dissected and reviewed multiple cases from May and voted to honor Police Officers Joseph Polak and Emmanuel Rodriguez.

These two astute street cops were both dispatched to a speeding vehicle assignment near Hicksville Middle School right before school started.

Employees of the school stated they saw a silver Mercedes SUV driving continuously erratic around the vicinity of the school. Shortly after canvassing southbound Jerusalem Avenue, Officer Rodriguez spotted the vehicle on 6th Street just south of the initial call location and attempted to pull him over. Said vehicle refused to pull over. As Officer Polak was on Jerusalem, the subject and his vehicle went through the stop sign at 6th Street and Jerusalem Avenue and almost collided with RMP 801. Officers Polak and Rodriguez then followed the subject who was driving in a reckless manor. While on 5th Street, Officer Rodriguez was almost struck head-on by defendant in the vehicle. The defendant then drove southbound on Jerusalem and made a left on 8th Street where he collided with a parked vehicle. It was then that Officer Rodriguez and Officer Breslin of the 2nd Precinct conducted a felony car stop, giving verbal commands to exit the vehicle. The subject was non compliant. Officer's Rodriguez and Breslin did attempt to remove subject from vehicle. 2nd Precinct members in an unmarked rmp were parked behind defendants vehicle at this time and defendant did reverse into their vehicle. Defendant refused commands and then resisted arrest. A 2nd Precinct unit did deploy his taser with no effect. Officers on scene were able to remove defendant from vehicle at which point he was resisting arrest when taken to the ground. The taser was redeployed and as a result Officer Rodriguez did get electrocuted and fell into the side of the defendants car. Officer Polak and Morante were then able to gain control of defendants arms and safely place him in handcuffs. While in handcuffs, the felon was making spontaneous statements. He was irrationally stating that his dogs own the car and they were telling him what to do. Officer Polak did observe defendant to be talkative, excited, disoriented and have a rigid tense muscle structure. He was also making incomplete verbal statements, and did appear to be having hallucinations.

Officer Rodriguez suffered from injuries to his knee, elbow, and hands as a result of the incident. Officer Rodriguez was taken to Northshore Plainview hospital in Ambulance 2358 for further medical attention. We are happy to report he was back to work shortly thereafter.

Defendant was placed into county ambulance 2392 with

the savvy veteran medic, Stephen Kahl, and Officer Morante. While in the back of the ambulance, the defendant did make a statement to a patrol supervisor who stated that he used cocaine. Defendant was transported to NUMC for further medical attention and to receive a blood test who was believed to be under the influence of drugs.

The Top Cop Committee convened and voted for **PO Joseph 'Joey' Johnson for June.** 

In mid-June, Johnson was dispatched for an aided assignment in Levittown in which the victim was drowning in a backyard pool. The aided was removed from the pool where he was unconscious and not breathing. CPR was immediately administered and the victim was revived due to the instinctive actions of PO Johnson.

PO Johnson may just be the nicest guy to step foot and work in the 8th since Sgt Mike 'smilin' Cario. Johnson is quick to respond to assignments and very thorough once he's arrived on the scene. When the committee came across this case, it was no surprise that these were the actions of JJ. We would like to congratulate him on this well-deserved award bestowed on him.

A retirement shout-out to PO David 'The Admiral' Robinson, one of our finest and longest tenured members here in the 8th. ### **GOOD GRAB**


On October 1st, 2022 Bureau of Special Operations Officers Collura and Curaba were conducting patrol in the Elmont area when they observed a vehicle traveling westbound on Hempstead Turnpike with no headlights on, no front license plate, and an inoperative tail light. Officers conducted a vehicle investigation and observed three occupants seated inside. While approaching the vehicle the operator and the front seat passenger were making furtive movements around the area where they were seated. Both front occupants were then asked to exit the vehicle. Officer Curaba directed the front passenger to exit the vehicle, and as he did the front passenger bladed himself away from Officer Curaba and reached towards his waistband. Officer Curaba was able to control the subject and then removed 20 individually wrapped plastic twists of crack cocaine. Officer Curaba then attempted to place the subject into custody and after a brief struggle they were finally able to handcuff the subject. The two other occupants of the vehicle were then placed in handcuffs for Officer safety. Officer Curaba then searched a jacket located on the passenger floorboard and felt a firearm from within the jacket. The front passenger who was already in handcuffs then did jump up without warning and flee on foot. Officer Mahon who arrived on scene to assist then engaged in a foot pursuit with the handcuffed subject and was able to place him back in custody. All three subjects were placed

into custody and transported to the fifth precinct for arrest processing. The gun recovered was determined to be a ghost gun which was loaded. The vehicle ended up having switched plates on it and the operator was driving with a suspended license. The operator was also found to have additional crack cocaine on him in his underwear. The operator and front seat passenger did have multiple open warrants within NYPD and Nassau County as well as open cases with the fifth squad. Great job by all involved!

Speed Loaders. Cushman Scooters with canvas doors and heaters that only worked when you were moving.

Election Day Poll Details. A Jack in your back pocket. Only two radio bands, North and South. ## Dear PBA Member,

Periodically, your PBA reminds its membership of appropriate steps that should be taken if you are called to Internal Affairs or become part of ANY department investigation. Recent events underscore the importance of involving the PBA and your legal counsel, me, as soon as possible.

Should you be called to Internal Affairs, be it as a witness or subject, you must notify your local PBA representative IMMEDIATELY. If you are deemed a subject, you have the right to have both a union representative and legal counsel with you during the interview. If the investigation is criminal in nature, call me first!

REMEMBER: You must be afforded a reasonable amount of time to contact a PBA representative and attorney. You have the right to confer with us both before and after questioning.

# YOUR PBA REPRESENTATIVES AND ATTORNEY ARE HERE TO PROTECT YOU!

In any situation, be it at Internal Affairs or otherwise, where you are asked to write a letter and there is even a remote possibility of discipline, be sure to begin the letter with the following statement:

"I am making this statement for administrative purposes only. I have not done so voluntarily, but in compliance with an order of a Superior Officer. This statement in no way constitutes any waiver of my rights, and this statement, or any part thereof, may not be used against me in any subsequent criminal proceeding."

Finally, upon notifying your PBA representative that you have been called to Internal Affairs as the subject of an investigation, we will arrange to meet prior to your interview at my office to review the facts and circumstances.
